VISA

A short-term visitor's(C-3) visa is sufficient for all the program participants. No special documents are required for a short-term visitor's visa. You should just submit a valid passport, a completed visa application form, and a recent photo to the nearest Korean Embassy or Consulate. In certain cases, you may need to submit a letter of invitation, which we will send to you after screening.

MEDICAL INSURANCE

The program fees do not cover medical insurance for participants. It is recommend that you arrange for your own medical insurance before arriving in Korea.

ACCOMMODATION

Student dormitory is available to the summer program participants. Dorm rooms are western-style with twin beds and a shower booth. Each room is fully furnished and is equipped with free LAN connections. Halls provide other subsidiary facilities such as laundry facilities(coined washing machines and dryers), student's lounge, and a gym.

COURSES

Beginner's Korean and culture class prepares students to introduce themselves, greet others, and generally get around in Korea. They learn basic vocabulary and expressions for requesting directions and information, shopping, and ordering in restaurants.

Intermediate Korean and culture class introduces materials such as newspapers, folk tales, and movies. Students learn direct and indirect speech forms and develop strategies for identifying main ideas.
