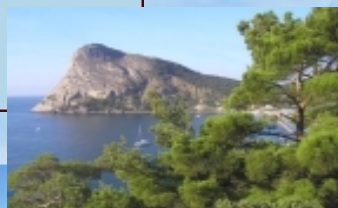


Venue

The Conference will be held in Alushta (Алушта), on the Crimean southern shore with a Mediterranean climate, the main resort and tourist area of Ukraine. Like the majority of Crimean settlements, Alushta is a very ancient town. Alushta city (Aluston fortress) was founded in the 6th century by the order of Emperor Justinian. The Alushta city area is notable for its rocky terrain. There are also remains of a Byzantine castle tower and a Genoese fortress of 15th century.


